LONDON

Enjoy some of London's famous free museums and galleries – our favourite places include the Wallace Collection, The National Gallery & The British Museum, where you may witness spectacular collections in architecturally inspiring surroundings

LONDON "DOWNTON STYLE"

This morning after breakfast meet your local guide who will take you on a half day private tour of London – there will be plenty of time for questions, photos and sightseeing!

Enjoy a Westminster Walking Tour and see some of the London film locations that appeared in Downton Abbey over the years, such as Spencer House and Buckingham Palace.

In the afternoon, treat yourself to a sumptuous **Traditional Afternoon Tea** at The Ritz, a quintessential British experience you will remember for a long time.





Highclere Castle & Lacock Village





This morning you will meet your local driver guide with private vehicle and depart London for the English countryside.

Arrive at Highclere Castle (the Real Downton Abbey) where you will enjoy access to the castle and grounds. Home to the Carnarvon family since 1679, Highclere Castle has been the iconic filming location doubling as Downton Abbey for all six series in addition to the film.

This afternoon, visit the National Trust village of Lacock – a favourite filming location for decades, not least for Downton Abbey! Home to the 13th-century Lacock Abbey, the village's rich history and traditions are embedded in every stone, making it a perfect stop on a Downton-themed journey into British rural history



DAY4



Bampton Village & Blenheim Palace

After breakfast at the hotel, travel to the picturesque village of Bampton, in Oxfordshire. It was here that many of the outside scenes of Downton Village and Crawley House were filmed and you will notice lots of well-known sites such as the church, the post office, Grantham Arms and The Dog & Duck pubs. You will also find Bampton Community Archive in the Old Grammar School, which posed as the hospital in Downton village

This afternoon, visit Blenheim Palace, the birthplace of Sir Winston Churchill and the current home to the 12th Duke of Marlborough. The Formal Gardens surround the Palace, and they include the majestic Water Terraces, the Duke's Private Italian Garden, the tranquil Secret Garden with all of its hidden treasures, the new Churchill Memorial Garden and the beautifully delicate Rose Garden. Overnight in the Cotswolds

YORKSHIRE - A ROYAL VISIT

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel and travel towards **Yorkshire**. Your first stop is **Wentworth Woodhouse** used in the film for its magnificent ballroom, creating the setting for the ball during the Royal visit.

After lunch the second stop of the day is Harewood House, where Lord and Lady Grantham's neighbours are preparing to throw a spectacular ball in the Downton Abbey movie. In real life, Harewood had close connections to the Royal Family during the period when the film is set. King George V's daughter, Princess Mary, became Countess of Harewood when she married the sixth Earl of Harewood in 1922.

THE DOWNTON LIFESTYLE





Enjoy a Yorkshire Breakfast before meeting your driver guide for a full day journey to **Beamish**, the Living Museum of the North, which reveals the history and traditions of life in north-east England in the 19th and early 20th centuries. In the film, various parts of Beamish were used as the setting for shopping scenes with Downton family cook, Mrs. Patmore

In the afternoon you will enjoy a stunningly picturesque journey on a steam train from Grosmont Station to Pickering Station by The North Yorkshire Moors Railway. The Railway travels through the beautiful and varied scenery of the North Yorkshire Moors National Park, which includes the amazing geological formation of Newtondale and the nature reserve of Fen Bog. You will overnight once again in York



DAY7

YORK - LONDON

Enjoy a Yorkshire Breakfast and some time at your leisure before checking out and heading to York Train station to board a train to London (2 hours). Private transfer from London Kings Cross station to your hotel.

Upon return back to London this afternoon, check in to your hotel and freshen up before enjoying a farewell dinner at none other than Rules Restaurant as featured in Downton Abbey where you will enjoy traditional British fine dining. Dress to impress and enjoy the unique atmosphere - this will truly be a night to remember!

You'll have a private transfer from the hotel to your restaurant and you are then free to return to the hotel at your leisure
