Immerse yourself in the mystical atmosphere as you delve into Ireland's prehistoric past as you explore these UNESCO World Heritage Sites, marvelling at the remarkable Neolithic burial mounds and intricate stone carvings that date back over 5,000 years. After of the Boyne Valley,

continue your voyage to Dublin, back to where the adventure started. Overnight in Dublin.

### Day Nine – *Dublin again for one last 'Craic'!*

Spend your penultimate day of your Irish adventure with a morning in Dublin at leisure.
