Day 4

Take in the iconic views at Tarn Hows, one of the region's most photographed spots, before returning to Bowness. In the afternoon, visit The World of Beatrix Potter Attraction, where her stories are brought to life through immersive exhibits and gardens, then finish with a Peter Rabbit™ afternoon tea inspired by Peter Rabbit, a perfect, family-friendly finale to a magical day.
