### *Day Two – Tootbus 24 hours!*

Return to central London via river cruise and use your pre-arranged ticket to ride the *London Eye*. Enjoy breathtaking views of the city skyline and capture memorable photos. Conclude your day with a relaxing cocktail at a riverside bar along the Thames.



### *Day Four – A Day of Cotswold's Charm and Rothschild Elegance!*
