

Day 1



Upon arrival into Manchester Airport; transfer to the city center. Spend the day exploring the city at your leisure with **Sightseeing Manchester's Hop On-Hop Off** bus tour; taking in key sights such as **Manchester Cathedral, Manchester United Football Club, Museum of Science & Industry** and **Town Hall Manchester** - to name but a few!
Overnight: Doubletree by Hilton Manchester Piccadilly



Day 2

Depart **Manchester** with a private driver guide for **Windermere** and enjoy a leisurely full day drive through the **Yorkshire Dales**: a vast expanse of rolling countryside and dramatic limestone valleys, dotted with traditional English villages, wildlife reserves and historic ruins. Highlights include the **Aysgarth Falls, the West Burton Cauldron Falls, Kinsley Crag** and **Malham Cove**
Overnight: Macdonald Old England (Windemere)

Day 3

Immerse yourself in a full day exploring the **Lake District** with a private driver guide. Highlights include the stunning **Kirkstone Pass** which is the highest pass in the Lake District; **Lowther Castle & Gardens** and **Ullswater** - the second largest lake in the District - where you can take a short cruise! Time allowing, visit **Shap Abbey** or **Haweswater** reservoir in Cumbria.
Overnight: Macdonald Old England (Windemere)

Day 4

Depart with private guide towards **Liverpool** and enjoy a wonderful panoramic city tour, making time for a visit to the world-famous **Beatles Story Museum**. Continue to the historic Roman city of **Chester**, taking time to explore "**Chester Rows**" - continuous half-timbered galleries, forming a row of shops. Afterwards, travel along the coast into **Wales** to **Llanduno**; an impressive Victorian seaside town.

Day 5

Continue your exploration of the Welsh countryside with a morning of touring, including a quick stop to view **Conwy Castle** from the bridge. Continue onto **Llanberis** for the **Snowdon Mountain Railway** to witness stunning views & breathtaking scenery. Travelling onwards through **Betws-y-Coed**, see **The Pontcysyllte Aqueduct**: a navigable aqueduct that carries the **Llangollen Canal** across the **River Dee**.
