#### Day One - Welcome to Belfast!

In the afternoon, visit Titanic Distillers to learn about Belfast's rich distilling heritage. Discover the distillery's unique process and sample some of their finest spirits.

Afterwards, continue your journey with an immersive experience at the Titanic Belfast Museum, where you can explore interactive exhibits detailing the construction, launch, and tragic sinking of the RMS Titanic. In the evening, unwind with a drink in one of Belfast's famous pub areas, such as the lively Cathedral Quarter, known for its traditional charm, live music, and vibrant atmosphere.

#### Day Three - Scenic Coastal Drive!

After checking out of your hotel, your private guide will collect you for a scenic drive to Derry along the stunning Coastal Route. En route, stop at the mystical Dark Hedges, a picturesque avenue of beech trees made famous by Game of Thrones. Capture memorable photos at this enchanting location. to Derry. Upon arrival, check into your hotel and spend the evening exploring this historic city. Stroll along the 17th-century city walls and conclude your day with dinner at a cosy local restaurant offering traditional Irish cuisine.

#### Day Four – Exploring Derry: History, Culture, and Local Flavours.!

Start your day with breakfast before meeting your private guide for the "Bogside History & City Walls Walking Tour."



This tour will give you a deeper understanding of Derry's turbulent history, focusing on the Troubles and the city's role in the civil rights movement. You'll visit important sites like the Bloody Sunday Memorial and the Bogside Artists' murals. Afterwards, head to the Museum of Free Derry to explore the city's past further, with exhibits and personal stories from that era. Take a break with a tea or coffee at the Craft Village Café, a delightful spot set within a reconstructed 19th-century courtyard. Next, tour the Guildhall, a striking neo-Gothic building with beautiful stained glass windows and an exhibition on Derry's history. You'll also visit St Columb's Cathedral and St Eugene's Cathedral, both included in your day pass along with several other attractions. Later in the

afternoon, enjoy lunch at the Walled City Brewery, where you can sample a variety of craft beers brewed on-site. The evening is yours to explore Derry at your own pace and have dinner at a local restaurant.

#### Day Five - A Day in the Countryside: Sheepdogs, Lough Neagh, and Farewell!

On your last day, your driver guide will take you to Glenshane Country Farm, where you can experience the tranquillity of the Northern Irish countryside with a sheepdog demonstration. Watch the skilled dogs in action as they herd sheep under the guidance of their handlers. Continue your journey with a visit to Lough Neagh, the largest freshwater lake in the British Isles. Learn about its natural beauty and cultural significance, including its importance to the surrounding wildlife. Take a leisurely walk along the shoreline and enjoy a light meal in one of the restaurant by the lake. After a day of exploration, your guide will drive you to the airport for your departure, ensuring you leave with wonderful memories of your trip.
